## Business & Economics Pathway



We are excited to offer students a range of business pathways, starting with our **Social Enterprise Project**. For the first time, we will be running this initiative within the school, giving students the chance to develop their entrepreneurial skills. Through the project, students receive business mentoring and the opportunity to secure capital to run their own ventures. Additionally, students have access to various enriching experiences, including:

- **Bank Visits:** Trips to Metro Bank and Lloyds Bank to learn about financial operations.
- **Virtual Experiences:** Online sessions with HSBC, providing insight into the banking industry.
- **Industry Talks:** Inspiring talks from leaders such as the CEO of BSI and the CEO of BAA.
- **Work Experience:** A partnership with Talent Foundry, offering work placements with KPMG, Barclays Life Skills, HSBC, M&G and more.

These experiences provide valuable guidance, equipping students with the knowledge and skills to navigate the business world and explore diverse career pathways.

## STEM Pathway



We are strong advocates for STEM subjects and have established excellent partnerships to provide our students with valuable opportunities. For example, through our collaboration with *DrivenByUs* this has allowed us to offer unique experience in Formula 1 & motorsports. As well as this we offer students experiences that expand their understanding of STEM careers. Some of the exciting opportunities we've provided include:

- **Exploring technology** in Formula e-cars at Excel London
- **Mechanical engineering careers** in aviation at the Excel London Aviation Day
- **Engineering Day** at Silverstone
- **F1 Stem careers day** at Williams Racing
- **Aviation day-** Excel centre
- **Mentoring** – Alumni and we encourage using Motivez STEM.

## Medicine Pathway



This year, we are offering 'Medic Mentoring' for sixth form students, helping them gain valuable insights into the medical field and support with UCAS applications. Additionally, we promote virtual work experience opportunities, allowing students to explore medicine in a practical setting. We've had the privilege of inviting inspiring speakers, including

- **Dr. Jason Yeun (PhD and Cancer Specialist)**- who shared a career path into medicine and research
- **Dr. Alayna** - who shared her career path into medicine with and offered mentoring for aspiring medics.

**Sharanjit K - Nuclear Medicine**, and offered mentoring for those aspiring for NHS careers.

We will also be offer support to Dentistry and veterinary sciences through mentoring and support with UCAS applications and virtual work experience.

## History & Politics Pathway



students have several opportunities to engage with History and politics

- **Parliament Visit:** Each year, politics students visit Parliament to experience the heart of government.
- **Mock Elections:** Students participate in school-wide mock elections, gaining hands-on political experience.
- **Law Career Support:** Aspiring law students are offered numerous virtual work experience opportunities.
- **Old Bailey Visit:** Aspiring law students visit the Old Bailey to observe live court cases, providing real-world insight into the legal system.
- **Enrichment days focusing on current political issues**

These experiences aim to enrich students' understanding of politics and law, preparing them for future careers in these fields.

## TV, Film, journalism and Art



students interested in film, drama, and art have access to exciting opportunities to explore these creative industries:

- **BBC Studios Visit:** Students visited the BBC for career guidance, meeting producers of *Einstein and the Bomb* and *Walking with Dinosaurs*. They learned about the production process — from scriptwriting to filming and promoting a series.
- **Partnership with London Screen academy-** students will get hands on experience with filming and production.
- **BAFTA Experience:** Students attended the BAFTAs in London, meeting the cast of *Horrible Histories* and a Cambridge graduate who shared his journey into TV and film.
- **Creative opportunities:** Our art department offers unique experiences, such as visits to Kitchen Soho to learn about art in marketing. Many students pursue art to enter fields like gaming, architecture, design, and marketing.

## Health & Social care Pathway



Students studying Health and Social Care have access to a wide range of career-focused opportunities:

- **Access Care Talk:** Amy Jenkins from Access Care spoke to students about careers in the care sector and offered employment opportunities.
- **NHS Insights:** Students engaged with doctors and NHS staff, learning about the importance of compassionate care and the variety of roles in healthcare.

These experiences help students build a deeper understanding of the sector and prepare them for meaningful careers in health and social care

## Apprenticeship Pathway



At UA6, we recognise the growing demand for apprenticeships and have taken steps to support our students in exploring these opportunities. This year, we have:

- **Financial Sector:** Hosted Lloyd's of London to discuss their apprenticeship programmes.
- **Business sector:** Welcomed alumni from PwC to share their apprenticeship experiences.
- **STEM:** Introduced the F1 Williams apprenticeship into engineering.
- **Construction:** Highlighted Bellway Construction's apprenticeship into the construction industry.
- **Aviation & Airports:** Invited GKN, London City Airport, and Cirium to discuss apprenticeships in aviation and airport operations.

## Higher Education Pathway



We collaborate with top universities to provide our students with opportunities to explore higher education through open days and specialized programs. Students gain valuable insights into university life, degree options, and campus culture. We currently work with the following universities:

- *Oxford University* – Open Days & outreach access programme

We also organise university trips to help students make informed decisions about their future studies.

We offer a unique one-to-one mentoring program for Year 12 & 13 students. We are also offering mentoring to those students aspiring to attend Cambridge or Oxford. Our team of dedicated, trained staff provides personalised support throughout the year, guiding students from their application process all the way to interview preparation. This tailored mentorship helps ensure that our students are fully prepared for the competitive application process and have the best chance of success.
