## Headteacher's Headlines

Faith-filled & hopeful

It's been another busy week here at UAI. We have many events coming up over the final 4 weeks of term and are very much looking forward to the exciting and ambitious curriculum enrichment day on Wednesday 24th.

A reminder that the Academy will close at **2.30pm on Friday 26th** June to facilitate an important staff event. We are grateful for your understanding and support, which enables us to invest in our staff and continue strengthening the provision we offer our young people.

You received a letter this week to inform families that from September 2026 the Academy will be implementing a full ban on smartphones and smart devices for all students in Years 7–11.

This decision reflects a growing national movement amongst school leaders and is being adopted by a number of schools across Redbridge and beyond. As educators, we are increasingly concerned about the impact that smartphones, social media and constant online connectivity can have on young people's wellbeing, concentration, relationships and learning.

Our priority is to create an environment where students can fully engage with their education, develop healthy friendships and enjoy opportunities to learn and grow without the distractions and pressures that smart devices can sometimes bring. We are confident that it is a positive step in supporting the wellbeing, safety and success of our students. We are interested in student responses to this and thus are encouraging students to speak with their form reps if they have concerns about this new policy.

## **Re: Change to School Rules Regarding Mobile Phones (Effective September 2026)**

I am writing to inform you of an important update to the school's behaviour policy which will come into effect from September 2026.

As part of our ongoing commitment to maintaining a calm, safe and focused learning environment for all students, the school will implement a **mobile phone-free policy** for students in Years 7-11.

### **From September 2026:**

Students in Years 7-11 will not be permitted to bring smartphones or smart watches onto the school site.

Smartphones and smart watches are now classified as prohibited items and may be searched for and confiscated if a student is found to be in possession of one.

Where communication is needed for the journey to and from school, we recommend that students bring a non-smart (basic) mobile phone. For clarity, a non-smart phone is defined as one that does not run apps and is not capable of accessing the internet.

Any non-smart phone brought into school must be switched off and kept in the student's bag at all times and must not be used at any point during the school day.

This change reflects the school's determination to minimise distractions, safeguard students, and promote positive behaviour and wellbeing. Evidence shows that reducing access to smartphones during the school day supports improved focus, reduces incidents of cyber-related issues, and contributes to a more positive school culture.

Where a student is found with a smartphone, it will be confiscated in line with the school behaviour policy. The first confiscation will be for 3 school days and will increase if there are further incidents.

We ask for your full support in ensuring that your child complies with this new expectation from September. By working together, we can ensure the best possible environment for learning and personal development.

Dear Parents and Carers,

The Met Office is forecasting temperatures above 26°C over the coming days. In line with our Hot Weather Protocol, we will be implementing a number of temporary arrangements to help keep students comfortable and support their wellbeing whilst ensuring that learning can continue effectively.

At The Ursuline Academy, the health and safety of our students and staff remains our priority. We would be grateful for your support with the following arrangements.

To help students stay cool, the following temporary adjustments will apply:

- Students are not required to wear their blazers.
- Students are encouraged not to wear sweaters or cardigans.
- Long-sleeved undergarments should not be worn beneath short-sleeved blouses and any underlayers should not be visible.

We would ask parents and carers to support students by ensuring they:

- Apply sunscreen before coming to school and bring it with them if reapplication is required.
- Bring a large, refillable water bottle each day.
- Stay well hydrated throughout the day.

Students will be encouraged to refill water bottles regularly and we will continue to remind them of the importance of drinking plenty of water.

We will also be taking a number of steps around the Academy to help maintain a comfortable learning environment, including ensuring that classrooms and indoor spaces are well ventilated wherever possible. We are putting in place a temporary timetable to ensure all rooms are a reasonable temperature. If we need to update the guidance or make further adjustments, I will write to you.

Thank you for your continued support. By working together, we can ensure that students remain safe, comfortable and ready to learn during periods of hot weather.

However, like many schools across the country, we are facing increasing financial pressures, making it more difficult to fund important improvements and enhancements to our facilities.

For many years, we have relied on voluntary contributions from parents and carers to help support projects that directly benefit our students. Free School Meals and Additional Funding:

If your daughter is eligible for Free School Meals, we strongly encourage you to register her, even if she chooses not to take a school meal. Registering for Free School Meals enables the school to receive additional government funding, known as Pupil Premium, which helps us provide extra support and opportunities for eligible students.

In addition, registered students may be entitled to assistance with educational visits, enrichment activities and other school-related costs. As we operate a cashless catering system, eligibility remains confidential and will not affect any other benefits you may receive.

Thank you for your continued support and generosity. By working together, we can ensure that Ursuline Academy Ilford continues to provide outstanding opportunities for our young women and remains a place where every student can thrive and achieve her full potential.

## Did you know...just registering your daughter for Free School Meals means that our school gets extra money!!

You can register your daughter for Free School Meals if you receive any of these benefits:

- Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400, as assessed by earnings from up to three of your most recent assessment periods)
  - Income Support
  - Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
  - Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
  - Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
  - The guaranteed element of Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income of no more than £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on – paid for four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit

If you want your daughter to have a free, healthy meal at lunchtime that's great – she will get a free meal (saving you more than £400 per year!). There is NO stigma attached and no one will know because we operate a cashless payment system in our Dining Hall.

If you qualify but don't want your daughter to have Free School Meals, please still register as the school will get additional funding. Your daughter can still continue to have her packed lunch as normal!

To apply please complete the on-line Free School Meals application on the [Redbridge.gov.uk](http://Redbridge.gov.uk) website. You can apply regardless of which borough you live in because your daughter attends a school in Redbridge. It is a simple 1-page form, so don't delay, apply today!!

It is important to note that:

- Taking the meal is recommended but not compulsory
- Your daughter may receive additional help as a result of being registered, for example, help with the cost of music lessons or school trips
- No one will know and it will not affect any other benefits you are claiming
- Registering your daughter for Free School Meals will bring in more money to our school.
